Mrs. Scholz's classes

Math 7th gr.: Scientific calculator with probability functions, pencils, notebook & a folder

Algebra I: Scientific calculator with probability functions, pencils, composition notebook and a folder.

Geometry: Scientific calculator or graphing calculator, pencils, notebooks, folders, compass, protractor and a small ruler.

Career Math: Graphing calculator TI 84 (highly recommended) or scientific calculator, notebooks, pencils and a folder.

Test Prep: Graphing calculator TI 84 (highly recommended), notebooks, pencils and a folder.

Study Skills: Notebook paper, folder, pencil

Mrs. Hovland's classes

Pre-Algebra grade 7: Scientific Calculator (TI-30XS is used on MCAs), pencils, folder and 2 small notebooks or 1 large notebook.

Geometry: Scientific Calculator or Graphing Calculator (TI84 is used on MCAs) would be better. Pencils, folder and at least 2 small notebooks or 1 large notebook.

Intro to College Algebra: Graphing calculator REQUIRED (TI84 is used on MCAs), pencils, folder, 2 small notebooks or 1 large notebook.

PreCalculus: Graphing calculator REQUIRED (TI84 is used on MCAs), pencils, folder, 2 small notebooks or 1 large notebook.

Algebra 2: Graphing calculator REQUIRED (TI84 is used on MCAs), pencils, folder, 2 small notebooks or 1 large notebook.

Mrs. Schleper's classes

Ag students in Welding and Woods: Non-spiral notebooks, 3 ring binder, pencil, calculator and tape measure, **safety glasses required**, pliers. Welding students must wear appropriate non-flammable clothing and closed shoes and no shorts.

Ag 8: Students must have a non-spiral notebook and folder for their work. They must also have a pair of safety glasses required, tape measure. They also need a couple of mechanical pencils for drafting, 3 ring binder, a protractor and a good eraser.

Ag 7: Students must have a non-spiral notebook and pen or pencil and a folder for their work.

All Ag classes: Notebooks for all Ag classes should be non-spiral type paper & 3 ring binders, students not having a pen or pencil or paper will be charged for the use of those supplies from the instructor.

- Students, gr. 1-6 are asked to provide a set of inexpensive headphones/ ear buds in a plastic ziplock bag. Please label the headphones with the student's first and last name.
- Elementary PE classes' requirement is a pair of tennis shoes to be left at school for PE classes only.

Kindergarten - Please Label Items -1 box of eight crayons, primary or regular size, 1 bottle of school glue and **many** glue sticks, two #2 lead pencils, a small 6 x 9 pencil box to fit in tote tray, 1 scissors, 1 pkg. multicolored construction paper, backpack, a small rug, blanket, or "Kinder Mat" is requested for rest time, **NO** large blankets or sleeping bags and one large box of facial tissues to share with class. *Some items will need to be replaced throughout the year.* *Kindergarten students do not need headphones, 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or other brand) and 1 package of sandwich or quart size baggies

Elem Special Education Students – Box of tissues, pencils, disinfecting wipes

Grade 1 - Please Label Items -4 oz. bottle of glue, 3 large glue sticks or 6 small glue sticks (resupply as needed), 3 folders with pocket to stay in school, 1-1" binder w/front sleeve, box of **24 or less** color crayons (**other sizes are not acceptable**), a second box (8-24) half way through the year, box of markers *8 basic colors, 10 yellow pencils (resupply as needed), 2 erasers (big individual eraser), 2 expo low odor white board markers (fine style), pencil box (small 6 x 9), writing tablet (not spiral notebook), good quality scissors, paint shirt, backpack * to carry papers home, one **large** box of facial tissues to share with class, 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or other brand) and 1 package of sandwich or quart size baggies

Grade 2 - A backpack (without wheels) to carry papers home*(backpacks with wheels don't fit in the lockers), **NO** individual hand pencil sharpeners, 8 regular pencils resupply as needed ***not mechanical**, 2-3 erasers, 1-4 oz. bottle of white glue and many glue sticks, scissors, a 12 inch ruler with centimeter & inch markings, a box of crayons, markers, pencil box or zippered pocket to hold supplies, 1 durable folder with pockets, 2 white board dry-erase wide tip markers and large box of facial tissues to share with the class.

Grades 3 & 4 - 24 pencils, scissors, pencil box/bag, 2 wide-ruled notebooks, blue folder, yellow folder, red folder, black folder, crayons, colored pencils, and markers, backpack, 3 glue sticks, 1 container of disinfecting wipes, pack of multi-colored expo markers, clean sock, protractor, calculator, 2 boxes of tissues, 1 highlighter, headphones

Grades 5 & 6 - Pencil box or pouch with 6 #2 lead pencils with eraser top, 3 mechanical .7 lead pencils, 4 red ink pens, colored pencils, 3 highlighters, non-pointed scissors, 3 notebooks, 1½ inch 3 ring binder (reading class), pocket folders for each subject area, calculator (prefer big display), protractor, compass, 12 inch ruler with standard and centimeter markings, **Ear Buds** for computer use, 2 large boxes of facial tissues to share with class, 1-container of disinfecting wipes and a backpack (without wheels). **PE classes:** T-shirts, shorts, sweats, socks, tennis shoes, deodorant, and a towel. Required \$5 deposit for padlock.
